GETTING TO KNOW ME

Have you ever thought of yourself as a basically "good", moral person?

INTO THE BIBLE

Read **Luke 18:18-21** and the parallel in **Mark 10:17-31**. What did the rich young man believe about the relationship between the law and himself? Why was he so thoroughly convinced of it?

What does Jesus say the man must do to get eternal life? What implications does that have for us? Must we also do the same? **Luke 18:22** Explain why or why not.

APPLICATION

Do you think it's possible that there are some people (perhaps even in our own church) who look very pious, are well spoken, "good", "moral" people who will not inherit eternal life?

Does Jesus teaching in this section change the way you think about the concept of salvation, and the way that you go about sharing the gospel? How?
