What impact does Jesus' statement in **John 14:6** have on all other religions?

Compare **John 14:6** with **John 11:25**. What are the similarities?

APPLICATION

In what ways does Jesus' being the Way, Truth and Life apply to our future? In what ways does it have application for us here and now?

How should the above impact the way we think and live?
