GETTING TO KNOW ME

Why do you think Peter was so confident in his ability to stand by/for Jesus?

Describe what you think happened. What went wrong?

INTO THE BIBLE

In **Mat. 26:33-35**, when Jesus said Peter would deny knowing Him, what did Peter say? Why did Peter respond the way he did?

Later, in Galilee, what did Jesus ask Peter? - **John 21:15-17**.

Why do you think Jesus asked that question three times?

What did Jesus mean when He told Peter to feed His sheep? - **1 Pet.5:1-3**.

After Peter was forgiven, what did he boast about? Read - **1 Pet. 1:1-9**

Why do you think Peter talked a lot about God’s grace, which is His special favor that we can never earn or deserve?
- **1 Peter 5:10-12**.

In **Lk. 22:3-34** what was Peter commanded to do after he would be restored?

Who was allowed to create a situation of great temptation for Peter and why?

APPLICATION

What are the differences between Juda’s betrayal of Jesus, and Peter’s?
